



Personal data processing principles

1. GE Gas Power, the organizer of the event, collects your personal data (categories refer to Point 2 as below) only for use within the scope of this event, such as event changes or award notice, funding-related procedures, awards ceremony and other non-profit activities.
2. Categories of the personal data to be collected:
 - C001-Type for identifying individuals (E.g., name, title, resident address, cell phone number, photograph, e-mail, as well as any other data which can identify the individual)
 - C002-Type for identifying finance (E.g., the number and name for financial institutions' account)
 - C003-Type for identifying in government data (E.g., certificate identity number or number of passport)
 - C011-Individual description (E.g., age, gender, date of birth, or nationality)
 - C038-Occupation
 - C051-Schools record (E.g., universities, colleges or other schools)
 - C052-Qualification or technique (E.g., qualification for diploma or professional technique)
 - C061-Current status of employment (E.g., title in the workplace)
3. The event organizer will use the personal data in January to December 2021 during the Powering Taiwan's Growth with Innovation, GE Innovation Challenge. The using area is limited to Taiwan only. The personal data viewing permission will be granted to our supervising partners such as Taoyuan City Government and Taiwan Power Company, as well as the contractors for this event.
4. The data subject's rights under Personal Data Protection Law and the methods for exercising such rights: (a.) the right to make an inquiry of and to review his/her personal data; (b.) the right to request a copy of his/her personal data; (c.) the right to supplement or correct his/her personal data; (d.) the right to demand the cessation of the collection, processing or use of his/her personal data; and (e.) the right to erase his/her personal data). The data subject's rights and interests that will be affected if he/she elects not to provide his/her personal data before the event ends.



Intellectual property rights & authorization matters

1. The project intellectual property rights belong to the participating teams. However, it is necessary to permanently authorize the organizer and related units to use/publish the project-related works for promoting GE Innovation Challenge on platform such as event website, press conference, or other medias.
2. All teams participating in this competition are deemed to have agreed to authorize the organizer to use the content of their entries and participants' personal information as they provided to the organizer (categories refer to Point 2 of the "Personal Data Processing Principles").
3. Patent applications may be affected due to participation in this competition. Teams interested in applying patent can apply to the Intellectual Property Office in advance.
4. Please give details or indicate the sources if there are materials cited in your project. Teams who violate relevant intellectual property regulations will be disqualified from the competition and need to return the winning prizes. The participating teams shall bear all legal and compensation liabilities.
5. The participating teams shall ensure the authenticity of all data and information. If any third party suffers losses due to the incorrect information in this challenge, the organizer shall not be liable for any legal or compensation.
6. The organizer reserves the right to interpret the provisions.

Withholding tax on prize money

1. For a taxpayer having any income from cash award or prize given in a contest or game competition, the tax withholder involved shall withhold tax payable at the time of payment as per the prescribed tax rates and withholding procedures, and pay the tax withheld in accordance with the provisions of Article 92 of Income Tax Act:
2. If the winner is an individual residing in Taiwan, 10% of the full payment is withheld. The prize value above NT\$1,001 but not exceed NT\$20,000 shall be exempted from tax being withheld, but still need to provide the winning receipt, photocopy of the front and back of the ID card, and the Taiwanese bank account to declare the income.
3. If the winner is an individual who does not live in Taiwan, 20% of the full payment is withheld regardless of any amount of the prize.
