## About Monitoring

The Monitoring feature enables usage metrics tracking. When a user signs in to APM, the actions for which usage metrics tracking have been enabled will be stored for that session and saved in-batch when the user signs out of APM.

**Note:** Usage metrics are recorded only for activities performed via the APM system. Usage metrics are not recorded for activities performed in the APM administrative applications.


# Define Settings for Monitoring

## About This Task

You can define the settings for usage metrics tracking via the Monitoring feature, accessible on the **Operations Manager** page.

## Procedure

1. In the module navigation menu, select **Admin > Operations Manager > Monitoring**. The page for the Monitoring feature appears.

2. In the **Monitoring** section, in box for each action, depending on whether or not you want the action to be tracked, modify the value to **True** or **False**.

**Note:** Disabling the tracking of an action does not clear any previously saved actions. It only disables the collection of future data.
