About Monitoring

The Monitoring feature enables usage metrics tracking. When a user signs in to APM, the actions for which usage metrics tracking have been enabled will be stored for that session and saved in-batch when the user signs out of APM.

Note: Usage metrics are recorded only for activities performed via the APM system. Usage metrics are not recorded for activities performed in the APM administrative applications.


Define Settings for Monitoring

You can define the settings for usage metrics tracking via the Monitoring feature, accessible on the **Operations Manager** page.

Procedure

1. In the module navigation menu, select **Admin > Operations Manager > Monitoring**. The page for the Monitoring feature appears.
