# Documentation Conventions

All capital letters	Identifies keyboard keys.	Press the ALT+F4 keys.
\\	Identifies the beginning of a folder path.	The query is located in the following Catalog folder: <b>\\Public\Meridium\Modules\Core\Queries</b> .
<b>Courier New</b>	Identifies text that you must type.	Type <b>root</b> .
<>	Indicates that the data inside the angle brackets is variable.	Click <b>Expand/Collapse &lt;Record&gt;'s Children</b> , where <Record> is the ID of the selected record.

[ ]	Indicates that the data inside the square brackets is optional.	<p>Type the following text: &lt;Meridium APM Catalog Path&gt;,[Query Parameters]</p> <p>...where:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• &lt;Meridium APM Catalog Path&gt; is the Catalog path of the desired query.</li><li>• [Query Prompt Value] is a value that you want to supply for a prompt in the query. If you do not pass in query prompt values, you will be prompted to supply them when you run the query.</li></ul>

# Asset Answers Integration System Requirements

The Asset Answers license is required to take advantage of the Asset Answers Integration functionality. In addition, your system must contain the basic architecture.

After you have installed and configured the basic system architecture, you will need to perform a few configuration tasks specifically for the Asset Answers integration.

# Installation, Upgrade, and Configuration

## First-Time Deployment Workflow

Deploying and configuring the Asset Answers Integration functionality for the first time includes completing the steps, which are outlined in the following table:

Asset Answers Integration is a new feature in V3.6.0.0.0, so there is no upgrade workflow from previous versions.

# Installation, Upgrade, and Configuration Steps

## Configuring Asset Answers Integration

The following instructions assume that you have activated the Asset Answers license.

To configure Asset Answers integration:

1. Access the Meridium APM Configuration Manager.
2. On the Configuration Manager main menu, click **Tools**, point to **Global Preferences**, and then click **Asset Answers URL**.

The **Asset Answers URL** dialog box appears.



3. If you have configured single sign-on for Asset Answers, type the Asset Answers URL in the **Asset Answers URL** text box, and click **OK**.

-or-

If you have not configured single sign-on for Asset Answers, leave the default value as is, and click **OK**.

Asset Answers integration is configured. You can now access Asset Answers through the Meridium APM Framework.





# User Instructions

## Accessing Asset Answers

To access Asset Answers from the Meridium APM Framework:

- On the Meridium APM Framework main menu, click **Go To**, point to **Failure Elimination**, and then click **Asset Answers**.

If you have configured single sign-on for Asset Answers, the Asset Answers home page appears. Otherwise, the Asset Answers login page appears, prompting you to enter your credentials.
