Note: Usage metrics are recorded only for activities performed via the GE Digital APM system. Usage metrics are not recorded for activities performed in the GE Digital APM administrative applications.


Define Settings for Monitoring

About This Task

You can define the settings for usage metrics tracking via the Monitoring feature, accessible on the **Operations Manager** page.

Procedure

1. In the **Applications** menu, navigate to **ADMIN > Operations Manager > Monitoring**. The page for the Monitoring feature appears.

2. In the **Monitoring** section, in box for each action, depending on whether or not you want the action to be tracked, modify the value to **True** or **False**.

Note: Disabling the tracking of an action does not clear any previously saved actions. It only disables the collection of future data.

3. In the upper-right corner of the page, select . A confirmation message appears, indicating that the monitoring settings have been defined.
